

Dr Suhaimi Suratman is a professor in Chemical Oceanography at Institute of Oceanography and Environment (INOS), Universiti Malaysia Terengganu (UMT). He obtained his B.Sc. (Hons) (Chemistry) and M.Sc. from the University of Malaya and PhD specialises in Chemical Oceanography at University of East Anglia, U.K. His research interests focus on the water quality studies (nutrients, metals, organic pollutants) especially in the river system, estuary and marine. His main research focus now is to understand the nutrient cycling in the marine waters of the southern South China Sea. Recently, Dr Suratman is selected as the local collaborator with researchers from the University of East Anglia for a project related to microplastics pollution. To date, he received 22 research grants valued RM4,719,710. He has presented and published many papers on the monitoring of environmental pollutants at various international, local journals and academic meetings.

Dr Suratman is also one of grant evaluator in UMT and at the ministerial level. At the same time, he reviewed many manuscripts from SCOPUS/Web of Science journals including Chemosphere, Journal of Environmental Management, Journal of Environmental Management and Assessment, International Journal of River Basin Management, Environmental Pollution, Sains Malaysiana, Journal of Sustainability Science and Management and Malaysian Applied Biology.
